

FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

Thank you for your entry. Your Start Number is 27 and your
Start Time is 9.27

Please adhere to these times and do not arrive late as Barracks will be closed
from 08.00 hours.

Please report to Barracks entrance map reference 106/005564 at least $1\frac{1}{2}$ hours
before your Start Time. Enter Barracks and give your pass to Army person in main box
opposite the Guard Room to gain entry to Barracks. Two passes are included with these
instructions, one for Rally Car and one for Service Vehicle. Once inside the Barracks
there will be no pass outs unless you have retired from the event and are going home.
Service crews must stay in the designated Service Area at all times, any crew found out
on the Stages will mean exclusion for their competitor.

Competitors proceed as directed by marshals to the Noise Check.

Remember that there is a 20 m.p.h. speed limit within the Army Barracks (except
Rally Stages) this will be strictly enforced and any competitor or service vehicle caught
speeding will be excluded from the event.

After successfully passing the noise check proceed as instructed to Scrutineering.
After Scrutineering park as directed (Whilst Rally cars are going to Noise Check/
Scrutineering, Service crews must park straight away as directed).

Both Rally crew members walk to Documentation and remember to have available:
RAC Competition Licence
Club Membership Cards
Advertising Licence (if appropriate)
Insurance Details

At Documentation Rally Numbers will be available for purchase.

You will also receive an envelope containing Rally Plates, Time Cards, Road Book,
Route Card, Stage Details, Damage Forms, Query Forms.

The first car will start at 09.00 hours

Full Catering Facilities will be available all day by Johnson Catering

No Service Crews/Vehicles will be allowed on to the Stages, the Organisers will
arrange to get Broken/Crashed Cars returned to the Paddock when it is safe to do so.

40% of Stage Surface is Chalk Track
60% Broken Tarmac
