RULES

1. The Club shall be known as the North Humberside Motor Club Ltd.

2. The objects for which the Club is established are:

(a) To hold, arrange, and/or promote, motoring events, rallies, races, car shows, hill climbs, gymkhanas, trials, matches, competitions and the like, and to offer and grant or contribute towards the provision of prizes, awards and distinctions, and to promote, give or support dinners, balls, concerts, social events and other entertainments, and to publish magazines and periodicals.

(b) To promote the sports and pastimes of motoring in all its branches and to encourage social intercourse between the members of the club.

(c) To carry on and maintain and conduct a club for the purposes of the said sports and pastimes.

(d) To subscribe to, become a member of or co-operate with any other association or club, whether incorporated or not, whose objects are altogether or in part similar to those of this Club.

(e) To support and subscribe to any charitable or public body and any institution, society or club which may be for the benefit of the Club, or its employees, or may be connected with the district in which any of the Club's property is situated, to give pensions, gratuities, Christmas boxes, or charitable aid to any persons who may have served the Club, or to the spouse, widow(er), children or other relatives and dependants of any such person; to make payments towards insurance; and to form and contribute to provident and benefit funds for the benefit of any persons employed by the Club.

(f) To purchase, take on lease or in exchange, hire or otherwise acquire any real or personal property and any rights or privileges which the Club may think necessary or convenient for the promotion of its objects, and to lay down roads, construct, maintain and alter any buildings or erections necessary or convenient for the work of the Club.

(g) To purchase, sell and deal in all kinds of articles, appliances and apparatus used in connection with motoring and all kinds of consumable stores and provisions alcoholic and non-alcoholic liquors, tobacco, cigars, cigarettes and other refreshments or things required or used by members of the Club and others, and to apply for and to obtain all licences and authorities necessary for the purpose aforesaid or any of them.

(h) To hire and employ all classes of persons considered necessary for the purpose of the Club and to pay them and to other persons in return for services rendered to the Club salaries, wages, fees, gratuities and pensions.

(i) To sell, let, mortgage, dispose of and turn to account all or any of the property or assets of the Club as may be thought expedient with a view to the promotion of its objects.

(j) To borrow or raise money for the purposes of the Club on such terms and on such security as may be thought fit.

(k) To invest the moneys of the Club not immediately required for its purposes in or upon such investments securities, or property as may be thought fit.

(l) To do all such things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects or any of them.

3. Membership.

Membership is open to all motor car enthusiasts subject to the approval of the committee. Membership of the Club shall not be utilised for any trade, advertising or business purposes and any members connected with the trade shall use their membership in their private capacity only.

(a) Election of Honorary Members.

The committee may elect as Honorary Members all members of Reigning Houses, and any persons distinguished for their political, scientific, literary, industrial and administrative capacities, or who have been distinguished in promoting the cause of Automobility.

4. The Club shall consist of:

(a) A President, (b) Vice Presidents, (c) Ordinary Members.

5. Members Liability.

(a) The liability of the members is limited.

(b) Every member of the Club undertakes to contribute to the assets of the Club, in the event of the same being wound up while he/she is a member, or within one year after he/she ceases to be a member, for the payment of debts and liabilities of the Club contracted before he/she ceases to be a member, and of the costs, charges and expenses of winding up, and for the adjustment of the rights of the contributories among themselves, such amount as may be required not exceeding £1.

(c) If upon the winding up or dissolution of the Club there remains, after the satisfaction of all debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever, the same shall not be paid to or distributed among the members of the Club, but shall be given or transferred to an institution or institutions established for the furtherance of motor sport or some other institution or institutions having charitable objects similar to the objects of the Club, and which shall prohibit the distribution of its or their income and property among its or their members to an extent at least as great as is imposed on the Club under or by virtue of clause 5(d) hereof, such institution or institutions to be determined by the members of the Club at or before the time of dissolution, and if and so far as effect cannot be given to such provision, then to some charitable object.

(d) The income and property of the Club, whencesoever derived, shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects of the Club as set forth in clause 2(a) to 2(l) above, and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly, by way of dividend, bonus or otherwise howsoever by way of profit, to the members of the Club.

6. Election of officers.

(a) The President, Vice Presidents, Hon. Auditor and a third of the committee shall be elected annually at the Annual General Meeting.

(b) The Hon. Secretary, Hon. Treasurer and Hon. Competition Secretary shall not be elected annually but nominations can be received by the committee at a date notified to members prior to the Annual General Meeting.

(c) No nominations will be allowed from the floor at the Annual General Meeting except at the discretion of the serving committee.

(d) The committee has powers to co-opt any member of the Club to serve on the full committee and that member has a vote on the committee to which he/she has been co-opted.

7. Committee

(a) The committee shall consist of nine members not including the Hon. Secretary, Hon. Treasurer, Hon. Competition Secretary and the Club Captain.

(b) The Chairman who shall be elected annually by the committee will have the right to vote as a committee member and also have the casting vote.

(c) Six form a quorum of the committee.

(d) The President can attend all committee and sub-committee meetings and is entitled to vote.

Meetings of the committee.

The committee shall meet whenever summoned by the Secretary, who may convene a meeting of his/her own accord, or shall do so by direction of the Chairman, or on a requisition signed by two thirds of the committee.

Absence from committee.

Any member of the committee who shall, without sufficient reason, absent himself/herself from two consecutive meetings, will be understood to have resigned from the committee.

Duties of the Hon. Secretary.

It shall be the duty of the Hon. Secretary to attend all meetings in person or by deputy, and to take minutes of the proceedings. Such minutes shall be read and presented for confirmation at the following meeting.

Banking.

All moneys of the Club shall be banked by the Treasurer or his/her deputy in the name of the Club, and no disbursements shall be made therefrom except in accordance with the form or forms authorised by the committee.

Subscriptions.

The amount will be fixed by the committee. Classes of membership will be at the discretion of the committee.

Non-Payment.

Any member of the Club who has not paid his/her subscription by 1st March may unless sufficient reason be shown to the satisfaction of the committee, be taken off the Register of Members forthwith. No member whose subscription is in arrears shall be eligible to take part in any competition. Subscriptions shall be due on 1st January.

Expulsion or Suspension of members.

In the event of any member being charged with such conduct as in the opinion of the committee would render it desirable that he/she should cease to be a member of the Club, he/she shall be invited to attend a meeting of the committee which shall enquire whether a cause of expulsion has arisen or not. If after enquiry the committee find that he/she has been guilty of such conduct, he/she may be cautioned or suspended or required to resign his/her membership for a specified period or may be expelled or except by a resolution supported by at least two-thirds of the members of the committee. Members who are expelled have the right to appeal at the next General Meeting. No member shall be expelled except

by a two-thirds of the majority of the voting members present at the General Meeting.

15. General Meeting.

The Annual General Meeting shall be convened in the middle of April. Twelve members shall form a quorum, but if within thirty minutes after the time fixed for the holding of the meeting a quorum not be present, the meeting shall be dissolved and all matters which might, if a quorum had been, have been done at the meeting so dissolved, may forthwith be done on behalf of the meeting by the meeting by the committee. A special General Meeting may be convened by the direction of the committee, or on a requisition to the Hon. Secretary stating the business for which the special General Meeting is required, and signed by not less than twelve members. If the meeting so requisitioned be not convened within twenty-one days the said twelve members may convene such meeting. Twelve members shall form a quorum. At least fourteen days notice of all General Meetings shall be given, but the non-receipt of such notice by any member shall not invalidate the proceedings.

16. Annual Accounts and Report.

The committee shall at the Annual General Meeting, submit in respect of the preceding year:—

(a) A full statement of accounts, duly audited for the year ending 31st December.

(b) A report of work done by the Club.

17. Agenda.

Should members desire a matter brought up at a General Meeting, the text of such matters, signed by at least two members, shall be sent to the Hon. Secretary at least fourteen days clear before the date of such meeting, so that it may be included in the agenda, which shall be sent to each member prior to the meeting. No business not included in the agenda shall be discussed at such meetings except at the Annual General Meeting provided that the majority of members present is in favour thereof. In the event of the proposer of any motion failing to move a resolution in respect of any particular item on the agenda, it shall be competent for any other member to move said resolution.

18. Voting.

At all General Meetings a resolution put to the vote of the meeting shall be decided by a show of hands by a majority of the members present in person and entitled to vote, unless before or upon the declaration of the result of the show of hands a poll be demanded in writing by the Chairman, or by at least three members present in person and entitled to vote, and unless a poll be so demanded a declaration by the Chairman of the meeting that a

resolution has been carried by a particular majority or lost, or not carried by a particular majority shall be conclusive evidence thereof, without proof of a number or proportion of the votes recorded in favour of or against such a resolution. If a poll be demanded in manner aforesaid, it shall be taken at such time and place, and in such manner as the Chairman of the meeting shall direct and the result of the poll shall be deemed the resolution of the meeting at which the poll was demanded. No poll shall be demanded on the election of the Chairman of the meeting, or on any question of adjournment. The demand of a poll shall not prevent the continuance of a meeting for the transaction of any other business other than the question on which the poll has been demanded. On any poll being taken for the purpose of electing members to committee, or members for honorary posts, the chairman of the meeting shall declare the number of vacancies. Any voting paper not bearing the same number of names as there are vacancies, shall be declared spoilt and invalid.

19. Right to be Present.

No one can take part in a General Meeting unless he/she has been duly elected and has paid his/her subscriptions according to these rules.

20. Observance and Interpretation of Rules.

Every member binds himself/herself to abide by the rules of the Club and by any modification thereof made in conformity of such rules, and also to accept as final and binding the decision of the committee in all cases of dispute or disagreement as to interpretation of the rules.

21. Alteration of Rules.

Any alteration of the rules may be made by Special or General Meeting, providing that the resolution proposing such alteration is carried by two-thirds of those present and voting at such Special or General Meeting.

22. General.

Every member shall be furnished with a copy of the Club rules and regulations on election.

Banking.

All monies of the Club shall be banked by the Treasurer or his/her deputy in the name of the Club, and no disbursements shall be made therefrom except in accordance with the form or forms authorised by the committee.

Subscriptions.

The amount will be fixed by the committee. Classes of membership will be at the discretion of the committee.

Non-Payment.

Any member of the Club who has not paid his/her subscription by 1st March may unless sufficient reason be shown to the satisfaction of the committee, be taken off the Register of Members forthwith. No member whose subscription is in arrears shall be eligible to take part in any competition. Subscriptions shall be due on 1st January.

Expulsion or Suspension of members.

In the event of any member being charged with such conduct as in the opinion of the committee would render it desirable that he/she should cease to be a member of the Club, he/she shall be invited to attend a meeting of the committee which shall enquire whether a cause of expulsion has arisen or not. If after enquiry the committee find that he/she has been guilty of such conduct, he/she may be cautioned or suspended or required to resign his/her membership for a specified period or may be expelled or except by a resolution supported by at least two-thirds of the members of the committee. Members who are expelled have the right to appeal at the next General Meeting. No member shall be expelled except

by a two-thirds of the majority of the voting members present at the General Meeting.

15. General Meeting.

The Annual General Meeting shall be convened in the middle of April. Twelve members shall form a quorum, but if within thirty minutes after the time fixed for the holding of the meeting a quorum not be present, the meeting shall be dissolved and all matters which might, if a quorum had been, have been done at the meeting so dissolved, may forthwith be done on behalf of the meeting by the meeting by the committee. A special General Meeting may be convened by the direction of the committee, or on a requisition to the Hon. Secretary stating the business for which the special General Meeting is required, and signed by not less than twelve members. If the meeting so requisitioned be not convened within twenty-one days the said twelve members may convene such meeting. Twelve members shall form a quorum. At least fourteen days notice of all General Meetings shall be given, but the non-receipt of such notice by any member shall not invalidate the proceedings.

16. Annual Accounts and Report.

The committee shall at the Annual General Meeting, submit in respect of the preceding year:—

(a) A full statement of accounts, duly audited for the year ending 31st December.

(b) A report of work done by the Club.

17. Agenda.

Should members desire a matter brought up at a General Meeting, the text of such matters, signed by at least two members, shall be sent to the Hon. Secretary at least fourteen days clear before the date of such meeting, so that it may be included in the agenda, which shall be sent to each member prior to the meeting. No business not included in the agenda shall be discussed at such meetings except at the Annual General Meeting provided that the majority of members present is in favour thereof. resolution has been carried by a particular majority or lost, or not carried by a particular majority shall be conclusive evidence thereof, without proof of a number or proportion of the votes recorded in favour of or against such a resolution. If a poll be demanded in manner aforesaid, it shall be taken at such time and place, and in such manner as the Chairman of the meeting shall direct and the result of the poll shall be deemed the resolution of the meeting at which the poll was demanded. No poll shall be demanded on the election of the Chairman of the meeting, or on any question of adjournment. The demand of a poll shall not prevent the continuance of a meeting for the transaction of any other business other than the question on which the poll has been demanded. On any poll being taken for the purpose of electing members to committee, or members for honorary posts, the chairman of the meeting shall declare the number of vacancies.
