FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

Thank you for your entry, we have a full entry of 40 cars plus reserves, so if you have to cancel for any reason, please let us know asap.

This year's event will start at Sutton on Derwent Village Hall, Main Street Sutton on Derwent, York YO41 4BN, this is also the finish venue.

There will be hot sandwiches and hot drinks, provided by the village hall committee, plus toilet facilities.

We will be on site by 9.0am. We would like to set off the first car around 10.00am, in order to get back for the classic gathering for around 1.30.

The route is about 80 miles and should take about 3 hours.

The finish is on the village green at Sutton upon Derwent, next to the hall. We are joining an informal gathering of classic cars, tractors, etc., there will be a BBQ and bar, plus other refreshments. A £3 voucher towards BBQ or the bar is included in the entry. (This cannot be used for breakfast). You can bring your own picnic if you like. We would be grateful if as many competitors as possible could stay a while to display their vehicle.

The road book will be in the form of tulip diagrams and will be straightforward to follow, you will not need a map. A clipboard and pen would be useful.

We have placed some letter boards along the route for you to find, this is just for fun, you do not need to take part in this.

There will be a start control setting cars off at minute intervals. It does not matter what order the cars leave the start, but we are trying to spread the event out a little bit.

There is no timing on the event. A course closing car will gather up the letter boards, so if you do stop enroute, the letter boards may have been gathered up.

FUEL

Fuel will be available at 4 and 42 miles

CAUTION

The event is using some narrow country lanes, the harvest is in full swing, so watch out for farm vehicles, as well as cyclists, some of the route is very popular with cyclists.

We have been informed by Sutton upon Derwent Parish Council that dogs (on a lead or unleashed) are **NOT** allowed on the village green (adjacent to the village hall). If you wish to bring a dog, please park on the car park.
