1. There will be no printed copies of paperwork available at the event – you must print your own paperwork.
2. You should already have received: Final Instructions (Competitor's Bulletin 1), a link to the Time Cards (for your use only), a link to the Road Book.
3. **SR 9:** The scrutineers may carry out spot checks of vehicles and/or competitors' equipment (overalls, helmets, etc.) at any time during the event.
4. **SR28:** Replace "Only one service vehicle will be allowed ..." with "Two service vehicles will be allowed ..."
5. **Starting order:** At MTC1, the two cars shown on the same minute on the Start List will start in the order shown on the Start List.
6. **Judges of Fact:** The following are named as Judges of Fact for failure to comply with GR R.25.6 (correct route on stages, reversing back to stop line, reverse direction on stage), false starts on a stage, unauthorised possession of pace notes, unauthorised servicing, unauthorised smoking, excessive noise & backfiring, crash helmet, seat belt, FHR and overalls regulations, misuse of SOS/OK cards, depositing of litter:

7. **Judges of Fact (Tyres):** The following are named as Judges of Fact for compliance of tyres with the SRs:

8. **MTC10** is the control at the end of the rally and R 30.3.3 applies: "30.3.3. At the end of a Rally or of any day of a Rally Competitors are allowed to check in in advance of their due time. ... Competitors arriving early must have their due time entered on the Time Card; those arriving later than their due time must have their actual time of arrival entered." Under Covid-19 protocols, the time will not be entered on your time card (it will be recorded on the control check sheet), but the remainder of the regulation applies.
9. **Stage Distances, Bogey Times, and Target Times** are as follows:
