CAVES CLASSIC TOUR 2021/REGULATIONS

THE EVENT

1. North Humberside Motor Club LTD will organise the Caves Classic Tour/Touring Assembly on Sunday 4th July 2021.
2. The event will be held under a Certificate of Exemption issued by Motorsport UK, these regulations and any written instructions that the organisers may issue for the event. The Motorsport UK Permit/Certificate of Exemption for this event is number 119566.

ELIGIBILITY

3. The event is open to all cars, but historic, classics and interesting or sporting modern cars would be especially welcome.
4. All cars should be presented in good condition, the Organisers reserve the right to decline any car showing damage.
Each car must be taxed for the road and have a valid MOT certificate if applicable.

INSURANCE

5. All entrant must ensure that their cars have adequate insurance to enter the event. This being a Touring Assembly with a Motorsport UK Certificate of Exemption their Public Liability Policy covers the event. However, this does not cover vehicle insurance under the Road Traffic Acts. A standard motor car policy may well cover the use of the car on a public highway. If in doubt please seek advice from your insurance company.

ENTRIES

6. Entries open on publications of these Regulations and close on Thursday 1st July 2021 at 20.00 hours. All entries must be made on the official entry form.
7. Entry forms and fees should be sent to the Secretary of the Meeting. On-line transfer payments are our preferred method of entries in 2021 due to COVID.

MAKE YOUR NAME CLEAR AS THE PAYEE. We have to reconcile your payment to the entry. The entry form can be emailed as an attachment (or posted) to the Secretary. Please do not send entry forms to the Secretary's mobile phone number. In exceptional circumstances cheques may be sent but contact the Secretary first. 8. The maximum number of cars on the event is 30. The minimum is 20. Should the minimum not be reached the organisers reserve the right to cancel the event and refund entry fees in full.
9. Each entry will be acknowledged by email unless you indicate preference for post. The cost of entries withdrawn in writing received prior to Tuesday 29th June 2021 will be refunded in full. There after the refunds will be at the organisers' discretion.
10. Final instructions will be issued no later than 5 days before the tour by email or post as requested in your entry form.

COVID-19

11. The event will be run in accordance with Government and Motorsport UK regulations in force at the date of the event. Therefore, all signing on must be completed prior to the event. No paperwork will be issued on the day as in previous years, but the road book and all paperwork will be emailed to entrants to download and print off themselves. If you are unable to print off your paperwork yourself, please contact the Secretary.

DOCUMENTATION

12. Cars and crews should arrive at the start at Drewtons Farm Shop from 8am and no later than 1 hour there after. You will have time to get your breakfast items and chat to fellow tourists.

ROUTE

13. The start is at Drewtons Farm Shop, South Cave. HU15 2AG. Telephone 01430 425079. A varied menu of breakfast items will be available for purchase at the start and these can be pre ordered, please see Drewtons website and quote "Caves Classic Run Breakfast". Served from 8.30 am.
The first car will leave at 9.30am and the cars will leave in 1 minute intervals to avoid bunching. Refreshments will be available at the half way holt and the finish.
14. The route will cover approximately 90 miles on asphalt roads in East Yorkshire and North East Lincolnshire. The route will be given in an easy to follow "TULIP" road book and should take you around 4 hours at an average of 24 MPH. Ordnance Survey maps 106,112,113 covers the route but maps are NOT needed for navigation. Along the route you will find letter boards for you to note down on the road book to ensure you are on the correct route. The Road Book will contain interval mileages, such as a particular hazard or where caution is advised.
15. As ever please be mindful of other road users such as cyclists, horse riders and walkers.

THE HUMBER BRIDGE

16. The route goes over the bridge but presently due to COVID, cash is NOT being taken for the toll. CARD PAYMENTS ONLY at £1.50 each way.
