Annual Classic Run

The Club is holding the Annual "Caves" Classic Car Run on Sunday 6th July 2025.

This event will be focussed on North and South Cave, East Yorkshire.

We have designed this Classic Event to be a navigational exercise for classic vehicles.

Navigation will be the prime focus of this event, and to this end, entrants may need O.S. map Sheets 106 & 107. The route will be approximately 70 miles and should take about 3.5 hours to complete, including a half hour break approximately half distance. There is no timing of the run but entrants should restrict their speed to an average of 24 m.p.h.

Fuel, refreshments and lavatories will be available at the half way halt.

Some of the roads used will be narrow, and subject to Farm Traffic. If the weather is inclement, the entrants may encounter mud on the road surface.

Entrants who do not feel the need to take part in the full navigational exercise will be able to follow the route fairly easily, if not exactly.

The route will be issued as a road book, marked with "Tulip" diagrams and mileages.

Mileages will be given as accurately as possible.

Not all junctions will be marked in the road book, and there will be a series of letter boards set out on the route to verify that entrants have taken the correct route.

It is open to any make of classic car registered before 1984 and modern sports tourers.

The Organisers would like to encourage competitors to avail themselves of the catering at the Start, Midway Halt and Finish venues.

Catering at the start. Tea/coffee and a hot sandwich will be included in the entry fee. There will be adequate seating, indoors or out. The Farm shop can also offer a selection of pre-packed sandwiches for the journey

The event will start at 09.30 from Drewyton's Farm Shop (the Kettlethorpe Farm Shop), and we finish at North Cave, William's Den at about 13.30

Catering at the finish:

We would encourage entrants to avail themselves of the food on offer at the start, halfway and finish venues, as this will help them, and us, justify our coming back to them for another year in the future. Hopefully, our presence will encourage others to the start and finish venues and in the same vein, we hope that their additional custom will encourage the proprietors to invite us again in the future. Neither the start, nor the finish venue is charging us for our presence.

The event is open to anyone with an appropriate car, we would encourage club members to promote the event, and enter — the more the merrier, as they say although entries will be limited to 35 this year in consideration of available parking spaces.
