START VENUE

The start and Finish venue is

SUTTON UPON DERWENT VILLAGE HALL

Sutton upon Derwent

Near York

YO41 4 BN

Volunteers from the village Hall will be providing refreshments at the start a hot drink and a hot sandwich is included in your entry fee, tickets will be in your pack

Extra Tickets can be purchased at the start

We have arranged to be on site from 8.30 am .

The first car is away at 9.45 anyone who wants to set off early to get back early they can. We would like all cars away by 10.30 am. There is no timing, but we would like cars to set off at a minimum of 1 minute intervals. There is no set order

The Spitfire Fly past is at 13.50

The route is about 70 miles and should take about 3 hours to complete.

The finish is on the village green at Sutton upon Derwent, next to the village hall. We are joining an informal gathering of classic cars, tractors, etc., there will be a BBQ and bar, plus other refreshments. The WI will also be doing tea and cakes. You can bring your own picnic if you like. We would be grateful if as many competitors as possible could stay a while to display their vehicle.

The road book will be in the form of tulip diagrams and will be straightforward to follow, you will **not** need a map. We have placed some letter boards along the route for you to find, this is just for fun, and you do not need to take part in this.

There will be a start control setting cars off at minute intervals. It does not matter what order the cars leave the start, but we are trying to spread the event out a little bit.

A course closing car will gather up the letter boards, so if you do stop on the route, the letter boards may have been gathered up.

FUEL

Fuel will be available at 48 Miles ,58 Miles and 60 miles on the route,

NOTE

On route instruction No. 41 in the road book you have the option to go off route to a café, you must return to this point and reset your trip to Zero. We have been told the café will be very busy

DOGS

We have been informed by Sutton upon Derwent Parish Council that dogs (on a lead or unleashed) are NOT allowed on the village green (adjacent to the village hall). If you wish to bring a dog, please park on the car park.
